1. Meeting called to order at 4:02
2. Roll call: John Gaytan, Josh Kalov, Sean Rabiola, Jacqueline Gaines, Erica Smith, Titia Crespo, Matthew Weinstock, Julie Artis
3. Approval of agenda: Mr. Weinstock motioned, Ms. Crespo seconded. Approved
4. Approval of minutes: Ms. Gaines motioned, Ms. Artis seconded. Approved
5. Announcements:
  - WatersToday Update: Waters Today has board positions opening up. Co-president, co-communications, co-treasurer, co-volunteer. Elections will be in June. Sales for tickets to Big Night are starting.
  - Ms. Smith said the LSC got an email from a parent asking for a more comprehensive approach to approving fundraisers similar to the one done for the Leukemia and Lymphoma Society.
6. Reports
  - 6.(1)Principal Report: Ms. Crespo said the past month had been busy with the 100 day celebration, Chinese New Year, hosting Girls in the Know and Pi Night. The school will be hosting after-school classes for tutoring from Selective Prep for MAP testing. There is a full slate for the LSC elections, will occur on report card pick up day. She also noted that Waters would again be a polling station for the state elections on March 20. The chess program is being filmed by WTTW and Mr. Prado elected for Blackhawks' charity initiative. She said that 7-8 graders will be doing a recognition of violence in Parkland and elsewhere. Waters conducts fire, lockdown, evacuation drills on a regular basis, she added. Do have protocols in place. Fire drills are monthly. Have told students and staff not to open doors; that people have to buzzed in.
  - 6.(2)BAC: March 23 meeting will be field trip and workshop on literacy. The BAC did hold a meeting in early March on Big Night, literacy strategies and how classroom are helping English learners.
  - 6.(3)Budget: Ms. Crespo said that Chase and CPS are having issues providing end-of-month statements. Ms. Artis added that the budget committee will wait and roll all of that into a report at next meeting. Ms. Smith noted that LSCs got communication from central office that budget will be released in April. Ms. Crespo has appealed the school's 20-day enrollment, which is used to determine baseline budget.
  - 6.(4) CIWP: Ms. Crespo said staff and teachers are assessing programs that are working and what needs to be tweaked.
  - 6.(5)Principal Evaluation: Ms. Gaines said the new 4-year contract will be signed tonight.
  - 6.(6)PPLC: Mr. Rabiola said STEAM night was very successful. Teachers have been talking about new curriculum and have begun planning for next school year. They are looking at CIWP priorities.
