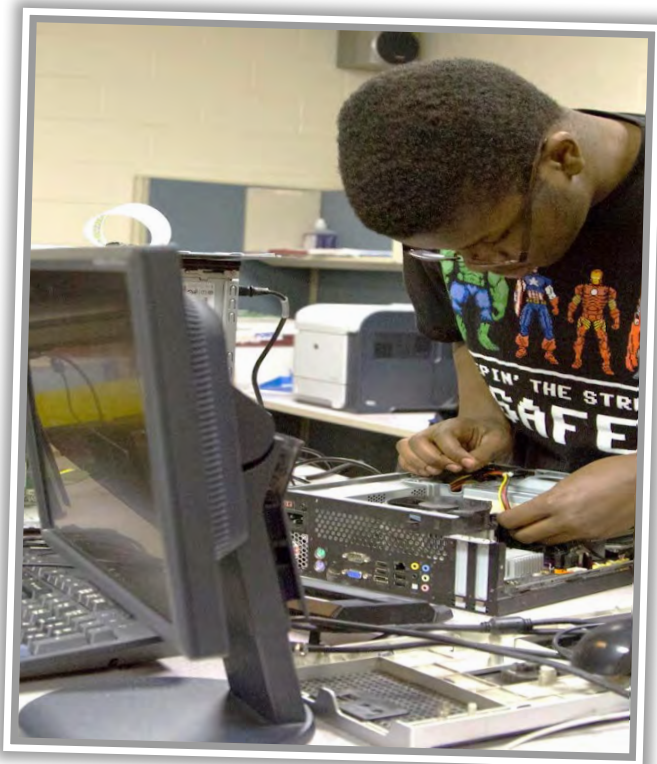


Career & Technical Education (CTE)

Culinary Arts

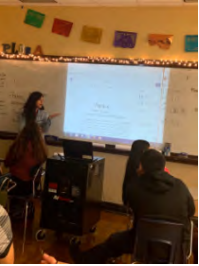


- Students learn the leading industry trends in cooking

Early Childhood Education - and coming soon: The Teachers Academy at Roosevelt High School

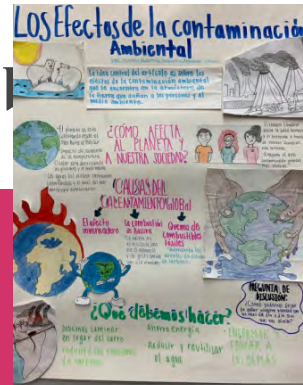


- Students learn techniques of working in Early Childhood Education

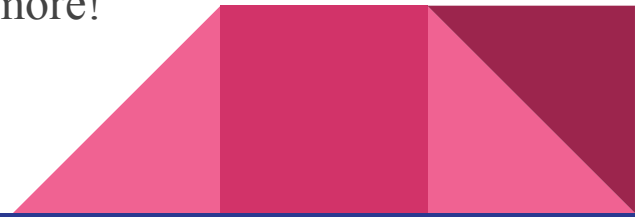




Why Choose Roosevelt?
